UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

Natasha C. Merle (Cal. No. 30) (PN82) Tax Convention with Chile (T. Cal. No. 1) (T. Doc. 112-8)

Ordered, That following disposition of the veto message with respect to S.J. Res. 11 on Wednesday, June 21, 2023, the Senate proceed to executive session to resume consideration of the nomination of Natasha C. Merle, of New York, to be United States District Judge for the Eastern District of New York.

Ordered further, That on Wednesday, June 21, 2023, the cloture motions on the nomination of Natasha C. Merle, of New York, to be United States District Judge for the Eastern District of New York and the Tax Convention with Chile ripen.

Ordered further, That with respect to the motions to invoke cloture on the above nomination and treaty, the mandatory quorum calls required under Rule XXII be waived.

Ordered further, That following the cloture vote on the Merle nomination, the Senate recess until 2:15 p.m. to allow for the weekly caucus meetings.

Ordered further, That if cloture has been invoked, all time be considered expired and the Senate vote on confirmation of the Merle nomination at 2:15 p.m.

Ordered further, That if any nominations are confirmed during Wednesday's session, the motions to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table and the President be immediately notified of the Senate's actions. (*Jun. 15, 20, 2023.*)
